## AN ACT

RELATING to Motor Vehicles; Providing That Application for Title for Motor Vehicle State 7 1at the Vehicle is Equipped With Approved Emission Control Device, and Amenting Section 28-303, Arizona Revised Statutes.

## Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:

Section 1. LÉGISLATIVE INTENT

Lo assure a clean and wholesome atmosphere, all sources of pollution must be contained and abated. It has been established that internal combustion engines as employed in automobiles are the major source of pollutants in the state of Arizona. Scientific developments have, however, established methods of restricting these emissions. Therefore, for the health and safety of all citizens in the state of Arizona, the legislature intends by this legislation to assure that all motor vehicles. new or used, will be equipped with emission control devices, that the state board of health establish standards for them, and that certificates of title would be issued only when the subject motor vehicle is equipped with such device or devices.

Sec. 2, Sec. 28-303. Arizona Revised Statutes, is amended to read:

28-303. APPLICATION FOR CERTIFICATE OF TITLE

A. Application for a certificate of title to a motor vehicle, trader or semitrater shall be made to the assessor of the county in which the owner resides upon a form furnished by the vehicle division. The application shall be signed by the owner and shall contain:

- The name of the manufacturer of the vehicle.

  - B. The application for a certificate of title to a new vehicle shall be accompanied by a certificate from the manufacturer showing the date of sale to the dealer or person first receiving it from the manufacturer, the name of the dealer or person and a description sufficient to identify the vehicle, and certifying that the vehicle was new when sold. If sold through a dealer, the dealer shall certify that the vehicle was new when sold to the applicant.
  - C. If the application is for a certificate of title to a specially constructed, reconstructed or foreign vehicle, such fact shall be stated in the pplication. With reference to every foreign vehicle which has been registered in another state or country, the owner thereof shall surrender to the vehicle division the number plates assigned to the vehicle, the registration card and certificate of title, certificate of ownership or other evidence of foreign registration, together with satisfactory evidence of ownership showing that applicant is the lawful owner or possessor of the vehicle.
  - D. When in the course of interstate operation of a vehicle registered in another state or country it is desirable to retain registration of the vehicle in the other state or country, the applicant need not follow the requirements of subsection C of this section but shall submit for inspection evidence of the foreign registration and ownership, and the vehicle division upon a proper showing shall register the vehicle, but shall not issue a certificate of title for it.

A foreign vehicle, before it may be registered in this state, shall be examined and inspected by the vehicle division or an officer or agent thereof, including examination and inspection to establish compliance with Section 28-955 under such conditions and standards as may be required by the state board of health.
