AN ACT

RELATING TO EDUCATION; PROVIDING FOR INSTRUCTION RELATING TO THE NATURE AND EFFECTS OF ALCOHOL, TOBACCO AND NARCOTIC AND DANGEROUS DRUGS ON THE HUMAN SYSTEM, AND AMENDING SECTION 15-1023, ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES.

1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:

2 Section 1. Legislative intent

3 The legislature intends by this act to strengthen and ex-  
4 pand the existing course of instruction in common and high  
5 schools which emphasizes and insures desirable health habits,  
6 attitudes and knowledge of the effects of alcohol and narcotics  
7 upon the physical, mental and emotional development of persons  
8 by including in such course the same instruction on the nature  
9 and effects of tobacco and dangerous drugs, including the plant  
10 cannabis and all substances and parts of the plant.

11 Sec. 2. Section 15-1023, Arizona Revised Statutes, is  
12 amended to read:

13 15-1023. Instruction on alcohol, tobacco and  
14 narcotic and dangerous drugs

15 A. Instruction on the nature AND EFFECTS of alcohol, and  
16 ~~narcotics-and-their-effects~~ TOBACCO, NARCOTIC DRUGS AND OTHER  
17 DANGEROUS DRUGS, INCLUDING THE PLANT CANNABIS AND ALL SUBSTANCES  
18 AND PARTS OF THE PLANT, on the human system shall be included in  
19 the courses of study in ~~grade~~ COMMON and high schools. The in-  
20 struction may be combined with health, science, citizenship or  
21 similar studies.

9 AND "DANGEROUS DRUG" AS DEFINED IN SECTION 32-1901, PARAGRAPH  
10 9, SHALL BE APPLICABLE TO THIS SECTION.
