AN ACT

RELATING TO EDUCATION; PROVIDING FOR INSTRUCTION RELATING TO THE NATURE AND EFFECTS OF ALCOHOL, TOPACCO AND NARCOTIC AND DANGER-OCS ORUGS ON THE HUMAN SYSTEM, AND AMENDING SECTION 15-1023, ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES.

1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:

Section 1. Legislative intent

The legislature intends by this act to strengthen and expand the existing course of instruction in common and high schools which emphasizes and insures desirable health habits, attitudes and knowledge of the effects of alcohol and narcotics upon the physical, mental and emotional development of persons by including in such course the same instruction on the nature and effects of tobacco and dangerous drugs, including the plant cannabis and all substances and carts of the plant.

15-1023. Instruction on alcohol, tobacco and

narcotic and dangerous drugs

A. Instruction on the nature AND EFFECTS of alcohol, and naresties-and-their-effects TOBACCO, NARCOTIC URUGE AND OTHER DANGEROUS DRUGS, INCLUDING THE PLANT CANNABIS AND ALL SUBSTANCES AND PARTS OF THE PLANT, on the human system shall be included in the courses of study in gende COMMON and high schools.
