- A. An arrest is made by an actual restraint of the per-7 son to be arrested, or by his submission to the custody of the 5 person making the arrest.
- 3 B. No unnecessary or unreasonable force shall be used
- 10 in making an arrest, and the person arrested shall not be
- ll subjected to any greater restraint than necessary for his
- 12 detention.

- 13 C. IF A PERSON HAS REASONABLE GROUNDS TO BELIEVE THAT
- 14 HE IS BEING ARRESTED BY A PEACE OFFICER, HE SHALL NOT USE
- 15 FORCE OR ANY WEAPON IN RESISTING ARREST TRRESPECTIVE OF
- 16 WHETHER THERE IS A LEGAL BASIS FOR THE ARREST.
