RELATING TO PUBLIC HEALTH AND SAFETY; REQUIRING THE BOARD OF HEALTH TO PROMULGATE REGULATIONS PERTAINING TO THE VOLATILITY OF GASOLINE, AND AMENDING TITLE 36, CHAPTER 14, ARTICLE 1, ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES, BY ADDING SECTION 36-1703.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:
- 2 Section 1. Title 36, chapter 14, article 1, Arizona Revised
- 3 Statutes, is amended by adding section 36-1703, to read:
- 4 36-1703. Volatility of gasoline; standards;
- 5 violation
- 6 THE BOARD OF HEALTH SHALL ESTABLISH BY REGULATION MAXIMUM
- 7 STANDARDS FOR THE VOLATILITY OF GASOLINE AT NINE POUNDS PER
- 8 SQUARE INCH REIL VAPOR PRESSURE AS DETERMINED BY THE AMERICAN
- 9 SOCIETY FOR TESTING MATERIALS TEST D 323-58 OR AN APPROPRI-
- 10 ATE TEST DETERMINED BY THE BOARD OF HEALTH FOR GASOLINE SOLD
- 11 IN THIS STATE. THE BOARD IN ADOPTING SUCH REGULATIONS SHALL
- 12 GIVE FULL CONSIDERATION TO CLIMATIC CONDITIONS AND MAY PROVIDE
- 13 THAT THE MAXIMUM STANDARDS IMPOSED THEREBY SHALL BE APPLICABLE
- 14 ONLY DURING THOSE PERIODS OF TIME AND ONLY IN THOSE AREAS,
- 15 WHICH THE BOARD DETERMINES NECESSARY IN ORDER TO CARRY OUT
- 16 THE PURPOSES OF THIS SECTION.
