AN ACT

RELATING TO COUNTIES; PRESCRIBING THE METHOD OF FILLING A VACANCY FOR THE OFFICE OF SUPERVISOR, AND AMENDING SECTION 11-213, ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES.

1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:

2 Section 1. Purpose

3 The purpose of this act is to alter the method of filling
4 a vacancy in the office of county supervisor by relieving the
5 clerk of the board from participating in filling the vacancy
6 and substituting the presiding judge of the superior court in
7 the county to assist in the selection.

8 Sec. 2. Section 11-213, Arizona Revised Statutes, is
9 amended to read:

10 11-213. Election; vacancies

11 A. At the general election for state and county officers,
12 one supervisor shall be elected from each district from among
13 those nominated at the preceding primary election. They shall
14 be nominated and elected by the qualified electors of their re-
15 spective districts. If a supervisor moves from the district from
16 which he was elected his office shall at once become vacant.

17 B. When a vacancy occurs in the office of supervisor, the
18 remaining supervisors, together with the ~~clerk-of-the-board-of~~
19 ~~supervisors~~, PRESIDING JUDGE OF THE SUPERIOR COURT IN THE COUNTY
20 IN WHICH THE VACANCY OCCURS, shall fill the vacancy by appoint-
21 ment of a resident of the district in which the vacancy occurred.
