RELATING TO TAXATION AND TRANSPORTATION; IMPOSING AN EXCISE TAX FOR CONSTRUCTION AND MAINTENANCE OF BICYCLE PATHWAYS; ESTABLISHING A PERMANENT BICYCLE PATHWAY CAPITAL OUTLAY REVOLVING FUND; AUTHORIZING DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION TO ESTABLISH STANDARDS FOR CONSTRUCTION OF SUCH PATHWAYS; AMENDING TITLE 28, ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES, BY ADDING CHAPTER 17, ARTICLE 1; AMENDING TITLE 42, CHAPTER 8, ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES, BY ADDING ARTICLE 1.3, AND MAKING AN APPROPRIATION.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:
Section 1. Title 28, Arizona Revised Statutes, is amended by adding chapter 17, article 1, sections 28-2201 through 28-2205, to read:
CHAPTER 17

BICYCLE PATHWAYS ARTICLE 1. IN GENERAL

28-2201. Definitions

IN THIS ARTICLE, UNLESS THE CONTEXT OTHERWISE REQUIRES:

- 1. "BICYCLE" NEANS EVERY DEVICE PROPELLED BY HUMAN POWER UPON MHICH ANY PERSON MAY RIDE, HAVING TWO TANDEM MHEELS EITHER OF WHICH IS MORE THAN SIXTEEN INCHES IN DIAMETER AND INCLUDES ANY DEVICE GENERALLY RECOGNIZED AS A BICYCLE THOUGH EQUIPPED WITH TWO FRONT OR REAR WHEELS. BICYCLE ALSO INCLUDES A DEVICE WHICH ALTHOUGH EQUIPPED WITH PEDALS, IS ASSISTED BY POWER FURNISHED TO THE DRIVE WHEEL THROUGH AN INDIRECT CONNECTION THERETO.
- 2. "BICYCLE LANE" MEANS AN AREA WITHIN A HIGHWAY OR SIDEWALK AREA, WHICH IS DESIGNED OR MARKED FOR EXCLUSIVE USE OF BICYCLES AND FROM WHICH MOTOR VEHICLES ARE PROHIBITED FROM OCCUPYING.
- 3. "BICYCLE PATH" MEMIS A MAY ESTABLISHED OR USED TO THE EXCLUSION OF OTHER VEHICLES OR MHICH IS NOT OPEN TO THE PUBLIC FOR USE BY VEHICLES OTHER THAN BICYCLES BUT MHICH MAY CROSS HIGHMAYS. "BICYCLE PATH" ALSO MEANS A WAY WITHIN A HIGHMAY MHICH IS SEPARATED FROM OTHER VEHICLES BY A BARRIER AT LEAST TWO FEET HIGHER THAN THE SURFACE OF THE HIGHMAY OR PATH.

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- 4. "BICYCLE PATHMAY" MEANS BICYCLE PATH OR BICYCLE LANE BUT NOT BICYCLE ROUTE.
- 5. "BICYCLE ROUTE" MEANS ANY MAY WHICH IS MARKED BY SIGNS BUT IS OTHERWISE UNIMPROYED OR UNMARKED.
 - "DEPARTMENT" MEANS THE DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION.

28-2202. Revolving fund; priority of use

- A. THERE IS ESTABLISHED A PERSONENT BICYCLE PATHWAY CAPITAL OUTLAY REVOLVING FUND FOR THE CONSTRUCTION AND MAINTENANCE OF BICYCLE PATHWAYS IN THIS STATE. CITIES, TOWNS, COUNTIES AND AGENCIES OF THIS STATE MAY APPLY TO THE DEPARTMENT FOR MONIES THEREFROM, BUT IN NO EVENT MAY AN AMOUNT PAID EXCEED FIFTY PERCENTUM OF THE TOTAL COST OF THE APPROVED PROJECT COST.
- B. AVAILABLE FUNDS SHALL BE APPLIED FIRST TO THE CONSTRUCTION OF BICYCLE PATHS BUT ANY REMAINING FUNDS MAY BE APPLIED TO CONSTRUCTION OR MARKING OF BICYCLE LANES.
- C. ALL MONIES DEPOSITED IN THE REVOLVING FUND ARE APPROPRIATED TO THE DEPARTMENT FOR USE AS PROVIDED IN THIS ARTICLE AND SHALL BE EXCIPT FROM THE PROVISIONS OF SECTION 35-190, RELATING TO THE LAPSING OF APPRO-PRIATIONS.

- 28-2203. Matching funds; procedure for application
 A. A CITY, TOWN, COUNTY OR AGENCY OF THIS STATE MAY APPLY TO THE DEPARTMENT FOR MONIES FROM THE BICYCLE PATHWAY CAPITAL OUTLAY REVOLVING FUND, PROYIDED:
- SUCH CITY, TOWN, COUNTY OR AGENCY OF THE STATE HAS APPROPRIATED AND BUDGETED FUNDS FROM SOME SOURCE OTHER THAN THE MONIES APPLIED FOR UNDER THIS ARTICLE WHICH WILL BE USED TO CONSTRUCT THE PROPOSED BICYCLE PATHWAY.
- THAT NO MONIES SHALL BE PAID FROM THE BICYCLE PATHMAY CAPITAL OUTLAY REVOLVING FUND FOR ESTABLISHING A BICYCLE ROUTE.
- B. A CITY, TOWN, COUNTY OR AGENCY OF THIS STATE DESIRING MATCHING FUNDS FROM THE BICYCLE PATHWAY CAPITAL OUTLAY REVOLVING FUND SHALL MAKE APPLICATION THEREFOR TO THE DEPARTMENT. SUCH APPLICATION SHALL CONTAIN A COMPREHENSIVE PLAN FOR BICYCLE PATHWAYS WITHIN ITS JURISDICTION WHICH SHALL HAVE BEEN COORDINATED WITH ADJACENT JURISDICTIONS AND APPROVED BY THE DEPARTMENT AND SHALL HAVE:
- 1. COMPLETE PLANS AND SPECIFICATIONS FOR CONSTRUCTION OR MARKING OF THE PROPOSED BICYCLE PATH OR LANE.
- 2. ESTIMATED COSTS OF CONSTRUCTION OR MARKING. INCLUDING NECESSARY RIGHTS-OF-WAY COSTS.
- 3. THE SOURCE OF MATCHING FUNDS, INCLUDING NECESSARY APPROVALS OR EVIDENCE OF GRANTS FROM THE FEDERAL GOVERNMENT FOR SUCH FUNDS.
 - 4. AN ESTIMATED TIME FOR COMPLETION OF THE PROJECT.
- MATCHING FUNDS MAY BE FROM ANY SOURCE EXCEPT THE BICYCLE PATHWAY CAPITAL OUTLAY REVOLVING FUND BUT SHALL NOT INCLUDE COSTS OF ENGINEERING AND DESIGN OF THE BICYCLE PATHWAY SUBMITTED NOR RIGHTS-OF-WAY COSTS.
- D. THE DEPARTMENT SHALL APPROVE OR DISAPPROVE THE PROJECT WITHIN MINETY WORKING DAYS AFTER RECEIPT OF THE APPLICATION.

28-2204. Power of eminent domain

THE STATE, CITIES, TOWNS AND COUNTIES OR OTHER PERSONS MAY EXERCISE THE POWER OF EMINENT DOMAIN TO ACQUIRE NECESSARY RIGHTS-OF-WAY FOR BICYCLE PATHS OR BICYCLE LAMES INCLUDING AREAS FOR RESTING WHICH ARE ADJACENT THERETO OR FOR AREAS IN OR UPON WHICH BICYCLES MAY BE PARKED WHILE NOT IN USE.

28-2205. Standards for establishment and construction

- A. THE DEPARTMENT MAY ENACT RULES ESTABLISHING STANDARDS FOR CONSTRUCTION OF BICYCLE PATHMAYS WHICH SHALL INCLUDE MINIMUM WIDTHS, GRADE, ROADBED CHARACTER AND TREATMENT, TYPE OF SEPARATION FROM OTHER VEHICULAR TRAFFIC, SIGNING AND SUCH OTHER RULES AS ARE INTENDED TO PROTECT THE MEALTH, SAFETY AND GENERAL WELFARE OF BICYCLE PATHMAY USERS AND OTHER NEMBERS OF THE PUBLIC.
- B. THE DEPARTMENT, CITIES, TOWNS, COUNTIES AND OTHER STATE AGENCIES MAY ALLOW THE USE OF RIGHTS-OF-MAY OR OTHER LANDS UNDER ITS JURISDICTION BY PERMIT, LICENSE OR OTHERWISE FOR BICYCLE PATHMAYS IF SUCH USE DOES NOT INTERFERE WITH THE CURRENT USE OF SUCH RIGHTS-OF-WAY OR LANDS OR ENDANGER OTHER USERS OF SUCH RIGHTS-OF-WAY OR LANDS. IN SUCH CASE, THE USE FOR A BICYCLE PATHWAY SHALL BE WITHOUT CHARGE FOR THE RIGHT-OF-WAY, UNLESS LAW REQUIRES OTHERWISE, IN WHICH CASE THE VALUE SHALL BE AS DETERMINED BY ACCEPTED APPRAISAL PRINCIPLES.
- Sec. 2. Title 42, chapter 8, Arizona Revised Statutes, is amended by adding article 1.3, sections 42-1381 and 42-1382, to read:

 ARTICLE 1.3. BICYCLE PATHWAY EXCISE TAX

42-1381. Levy of tax

A. THERE IS LEVIED AND SHALL BE COLLECTED BY THE DEPARTMENT OF

REVENUE A TAX:

1. ON THE PRIVILEGE OF DOING BUSINESS IN THIS STATE, MEASURED BY THE AMOUNT OR VOLUME OF BUSINESS TRANSACTED BY PERSONS ON ACCOUNT OF THEIR BUSINESS ACTIVITIES, AT THE RATE OF ONE-HALF OF ONE PER CENT AGAINST VALUES, GROSS PROCEEDS OF SALES, OR GROSS INCOME, AS THE CASE MAY BE, ON THE SALE OF BICYCLES AT RETAIL, IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE PROVISIONS AS SET FORTH IN ARTICLE 1 OF THIS CHAPTER.

2. ON THE STORAGE OR USE IN THIS STATE OF BICYCLES SOLD AT RETAIL. AT THE RATE OF ONE-HALF OF ONE PER CENT, IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE PROVI-

SIONS OF ARTICLE 2 OF THIS CHAPTER.

B. THE TAX LEVIED AND COLLECTED UNDER THE TERMS OF THIS ARTICLE IS DESIGNATED AS THE "BICYCLE PATHWAY EXCISE TAX".

42-1382. Administration

UNLESS THE CONTEXT OTHERWISE REQUIRES, THE PROVISIONS OF ARTICLE I OF THIS CHAPTER SHALL GOVERN THE ADMINISTRATION OF THE TAX IMPOSED BY PARAGRAPH I, SUBSECTION A, SECTION 42-1381, AND THE PROVISIONS OF ARTICLE 2 OF THIS CHAPTER SHALL GOVERN THE ADMINISTRATION OF THE TAX IMPOSED BY PARAGRAPH 2, SUBSECTION A, SECTION 42-1381, HOMEVER:

PARAGRAPH 2, SUBSECTION A, SECTION 42-1381, HOMEVER:

1. NO SEPARATE LICENSE, RETURN OR RECORD SHALL BE REQUIRED, MADE OR KEPT OR FILED, AND THE TAX DUE UNDER PARAGRAPH 1, SUBSECTION A, SECTION 42-1381, SHALL BE INCLUDED AND REPORTED, SHOWN AND PAID WITH THE TRANSACTION PRIVILEGE TAX IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE PROVISIONS OF ARTICLE 1 OF THIS CHAPTER. THE TAX DUE UNDER PARAGRAPH 2, SUBSECTION A, SECTION 42-1381, SHALL BE INCLUDED AND REPORTED, SHOWN AND PAID WITH THE USE TAX IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE PROVISIONS OF ARTICLE 2 OF THIS CHAPTER.

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38 39 40 4. THE DEPARTMENT OF REVENUE SHALL EACH DAY REMIT ALL REVENUES COLLECTED UNDER THIS ARTICLE TO THE STATE TREASURER AND THE STATE TREASURER SHALL CREDIT THE PAYMENTS TO A FUND DESIGNATED AS THE BICYCLE PATHWAY EXCISE TAX CLEARING ACCOUNT.

5. AFTER DEDUCTING FROM THE BICYCLE PATHWAY EXCISE TAX CLEARING ACCOUNT, ONLY MARRANTS DRAWN AGAINST THE ACCOUNT BY THE APPLICATION OF SECTIONS 42-1326, 42-1339 AND 42-1413, THE WHOLE OF THE BALANCE THEN REMAINING, WITHOUT ANY FURTHER DEDUCTIONS, SHALL BE CREDITED TO THE PERMANENT BICYCLE PATHMAY CAPITAL OUTLAY REVOLVING FUND ESTABLISHED BY SECTION 28-2202, AND SHALL BE APPROPRIATED EACH YEAR FOR THE PURPOSES AS PROVIDED IN TITLE 28, CHAPTER 17. THE STATE TAX COMMISSION SHALL MAKE AN ESTIMATE OF THE AMOUNT OF MONEY TO BE RECEIVED UNDER THIS ARTICLE. AS REDUIRED BY SECTION 42-108.01.

6. THE TAX IMPOSED BY THIS ARTICLE SHALL BE A LIEN UPON THE PROP-ERTY OF ANY PERSON SUBJECT TO THE TAX TO THE EXTENT PROVIDED IN SECTION 42-1337 AND MAY BE INCLUDED, WITHOUT SEGREGATION, IN ANY LIEN FILED FOR UNPAID TAXES UNDER THE PROVISIONS OF THAT SECTION.

7. ANY PERSON AGGRIEVED BY THE ENFORCEMENT OF ANY PROVISIONS OF THIS ARTICLE SHALL HAVE THE RIGHT OF PROTEST AND APPEAL AS PROVIDED BY SECTIONS 42-1338 AND 42-1339.

Sec. 3. Appropriation; purpose; exemption; reversion A. The sum of one million five hundred thousand dollars is appropriated to the department of transportation to be used in administering the provisions of this act.

B. The appropriation made by this act is exempt from the provisions of section 35-190, Arizona Revised Statutes, relating to lapsing of appropriations, except that any funds thereof remaining unexpended or unencumbered on July 1, 1975 shall on that date revert to the state general fund.
